WHAT IT IS

Wolf is the male creative energy of the universe. Normally, we express it to each other sexually but, it can be expressed any number of ways even just with your presence

Wolf practitioners encourage one another to express their primal side, a true side, intimately and to express it in day-to-day life as well. We call this aspect of their personality their "wolf" side.

Wolves are self assertive alphas. We express positive male energy, a counter to toxic masculinity. We are secure and ensure that others are protected and self assured as well. We help others fight their own battles.

We normalize sex, gay sex in particular, as a healing and growth act that benefits everyone. Sex is not something to be ashamed of, to hide, or to isolate.

Wolf is a marker of self realization and empowerment. Think for yourself. Ask questions and sort things out. Seek the hard truths and embrace the hard decisions. Come out of the shell, come out of safety, and stand in your power.

As with all practices, this is a journey of growth. To be called a wolf is to simply have started on your path.

WHAT WE PRACTICE

Wolves recognize other wolves. Everyone who has been deemed a wolf has the ability to name another as a wolf. Once you have given a new wolf a name they become part of the Wolf-pack.

The Wolf-pack has no formal organization, no leaders, or no dues or obligations other than to that of Wolf. We are a pack of alphas and brothers.

Wolf Father is the term for the person who named you. Wolf Pup is whoever is named by the father. There is an unspoken responsibility for the father to guide the pup.

We are strange and do not fit in the status quo, but our role is important because we are healers. We empower people in to bloom like flowers just by walking by. While sex is the most potent transfer of energy, and the most fun, it is not required, and we can shine our energy into the world in any circumstance for any person to take in. The energy radiates and consent is given by the person accepting it into them on their own. We do not force ourselves.

You do not owe wolf energy to anyone. You give when you feel compelled and withhold when it feels wrong. Some may demand of you and you have the right to

decide whether you oblige. Both you and Wolf have veto power over one another.

Wolves do not demean. We reject an ego that self aggrandizes. That behavior attracts ticks, the negative, and will drain you. We are not gods, rather, we are channels for energy to flow through.

Wolf practitioners have no conflict with sex workers, however, we are not to exchange our wolf work for money. This extends beyond sex. Wolf should never be hidden behind a money barrier.

In your own practice, you will find others who resonate with you. They will feed off of your energy and you will be recharged in return. These encounters may give the other person just what they need for that day, it may help them grow, it may pass on through, or it may result in a new wolf. It is not up to us how it is received or why it is needed.

We do not decide the why. We work with Wolf and the results are not up to us.

WHAT IT MEANS

Wolf energy is our creative life force, as well as the universal creative life force, shared and expressed through us. This energy can be used to heal, transform, nourish, or not used at all. It can also be drained from us both by our own bad decisions but also by people that are connected to us that shouldn't be.

Wolf is the name for the God energy and also the manifestation of how that energy portrays itself through us. Our wolf sides are projections. It is like a light being shone through a translucent stone. The white light of the source is changed by the color of the stone, and that color is shone out into the world. Some stones are black, some are red, some are blue, the outcome looks different but the source is the same.

All wolves that you meet are different expressions of the same source. For this reason, each wolf will have their own understanding of what Wolf means both for themselves and for their brothers. It is important to note that each of us only has a fragment of the truth, and we should seek out other viewpoints rather than childishly see our own as the only valid one.

Wolf practitioners are monotheists. We believe in the same God that goes by many other names. We believe in energy reincarnation and that we are connected and will meet again in another form.

Ours is a God of connections, synchronization, and nuance. Events are interconnected and lead to one another, expressing a higher view in unexpected ways and proving itself in the uncanny. Wolf adores coincidence.

You are a human with god energy flowing through you out into the world. You are wolf's entrance into the physical realm. You are wolf's dick, but also a mouth and a set of hands. Do not limit what can happen or how. Everything a wolf does is Wolf's work.

Embrace today for what it is. Embrace people for where they are. Do not be frustrated by the day to day and instead focus on the bigger picture. See the connections and feel the outcomes. You are in a river. You can swim against it, or you can go with the flow, but no matter what you do the river will always run.

We change the world by being our true selves, however, it is not within our human mind's ability to appreciate the

scope of that change, when it will be noticeable, or how far it will reach.

Many people will not be ready to hear what you have to say, but they are starving for the energy you represent. You can explain how a well works as much as you like, but to the person who is thirsty, all they care about is the water. For this reason, you do not need to explain yourself to anyone. There is no reason to justify your behaviors or your beliefs as there is little chance that the other party will understand. Your existence is justification enough.

You are wolf's portal into this world. Let his light radiate into everything you do. It nourishes the grass you walk on. It heals without you knowing. It changes the world without you noticing.

Be you.



WHAT COMES AFTER

Wolves are able to psychically sense the thoughts and feelings of other people, usually this must be done with consent, however, we often times will feel it instinctually. Wolves are also able to connect into other wolves and feel their energy- particularly when they're having sex. Two fully connected and consensual wolves may be able to experience each other's orgasms, feelings, thoughts, or more.

Wolf grants some psychic abilities as well. We refer to this as "sniffing" or an "instinct." You may sense illness in someone, possible outcomes of events, energy transfer, bad intentions, the feelings of animals, or other useful information. It is wise though to keep the majority of this information to yourself and only use it as a guide for your own actions. Telling someone that you smelled cancer on them could make them adore you, distrust you, angry at you, or worst of all, prevent them from ever seeking treatment because they wish to deny you.

People may come to seek wolf without realizing it. This is called seeding in the more it takes hold, the more that they grow and change and become their true selves. Some people may become addicted to this while others may never actually fully bloom, but you will find that people are attracted to you and cannot explain why, because, they are

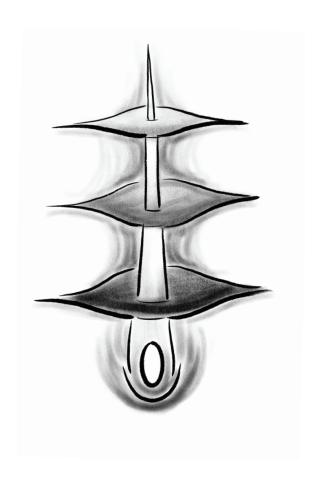

actually attracted to Wolf. You just happen to be representing it. This is why controlling the ego is so important because it is very easy for a wolf to believe that they are above everyone else, especially when people appear to want to worship them.

As you grow, you will recognize the potential for Wolf inside of others. There is a great temptation to share everything immediatly, however, this can cause problems for you and the potential wolf. Wherever possible, let Wolf teach the pup as you continue to interact with them. Introduce concepts to them slowly as the opportunity arises and follow your instincts. The process is usually slow and varies by person, forcing it to speed up though can cause a lot of pain for everyone. Some potentials will never be ready in this lifetime, and that's OK. We are not here to recruit, we are here to grow what has already been planted.

Eventually, the pup will reach their testing. This will be a major life event that forces them to choose between their old manner of thinking and the new manner of thinking that Wolf has instilled in them. As painful as it is to the father, a testing is the sole responsibility of the poten-

tial wolf. We are only able to watch and provide a safe environment, just as how a chick, hatching from an egg, cannot be forced out. To not allow the chick to break free on their own would be to rip the lining of the egg out... along with their organs.

Once a testing has passed, if they chose the Wolf path, then they will be ready to be formally named and taught with directness and transparency. Those who choose to name a new wolf, to make a new wolf, have the responsibility to guide the pup, because you yourself have placed an enormous responsibility upon them. They will become like family to you because they are.

Your pup will mature and become your equal, your brother, and they will go on to mentor their own pups. As for you, the father, you will continue to grow and learn as Wolf teaches you. There is never an end to this process of growth and exploration.



Sparking:

Sparking is the term we use for engaging wolf god energy. It appears differently to others but is essentially a pull of energy from outside of you, through you, and into a space or person. Some people perceive themselves as transforming, becoming a wolf, while others see flames and light coming in and going out of their body. Breathing may intensify and other behaviors may change during sparking, but the marker is simply that you feel an elevated state. The other people present will also be able to sense a shift.

Wolf energy is both radiated consciously through a choice to spark or simply by your presence when you are in the correct state of mind. Wolf practitioners are not, by default, in this state, so pups especially have to work on engaging this energy while it will come more naturally for older wolves.

New pups, even named pups, will not be able to self generate this spark at first and may come back to their father wolves to re-energize. Sparking is difficult and the father wolf should exercise patience and feed the pup as needed until the pup is able to generate wolf energy on their own.



Healing and Sex:

wolves transfer energy during sex and during other circumstances by radiating energy. This energy is channeled through us from wolf god energy and into the receiver. In the process we are also charged. This is the reason we call most sex "feeding" because both parties are receiving energy.

We offer this energy freely to those that we decide to share it with. You will find that many people respond positively to it and will leave the encounter in a better place. Some people may become addicted to the energy and you will find them wanting more and more. Still others will seek it out to drain you and attempt to take all of your energy. You owe sex to no one and are not obligated ever by wolf to do so, so choose your partners well and be aware of their intentions.

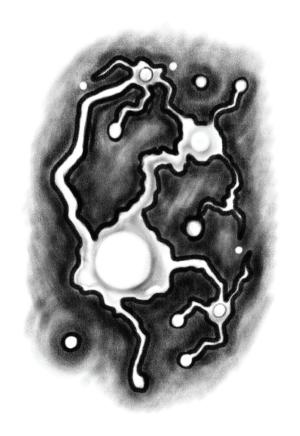


Energy connections:

Contact with another person in any form has the chance of creating an energy connection between the two individuals. These channels are where psychic information, or instinct, are transferred. You may sense something about a person because you are connected, even if briefly.

Positive energy connections with others grow and solidify over time and can provide good energy for both parties. These connections are usually perceived as golden or white. Negative connections can also be formed, usually by people who are unconsciously eating energy from you. These leach connections usually appear on a purple or bruised blue color when perceived. The extent of, or size, of the connection determines how freely energy and information can transfer between the connected persons.

Sex inherently generates a connection and wolf practitioners should be aware that this is happening. In your inner mind and meditation practice visualize your connections to people and "cut" or "burn" off those connections that do not serve you. You can also stoke your inner flame to the point of burning all negative connections away.



Energy color and Symbols:

Every wolf perceived the spiritual energy in a different manner. One wolf may see a ball of blue lighting while the other may perceive a blue flame. Each of us interpret our other sense through our own lenses, so the symbols are often different, however, the colors are usually the same.

When you attempt to communicate or interpret the meaning of what you are perceiving, explore first what the symbol means to you as that is what the energy is actually saying. Our sounds are using whatever wordless tools they have on hand to communicate and they are pulling from our own brains to form that communication. Every brain is different, so every symbolic language is different, even if they are all saying the same thing.

Always question what you are sending and perceiving in someone and trust the inner mind visual sensation over any concrete image. You may not see a spark seed into someone, but you will certainly be able to feel a change inside of them.

Linking in:

Wolves with established positive connections between another are able to "link in" to one another through their channels. This can be anywhere from a simple check in, seeing how the person is doing emotionally, to full on shared experiences such when two wolves experience a feeding together even when one is not physically present.

The information in these channels are almost exclusively emotional and are the inner emotions of the person being read. It is difficult to ascertain a physical location or surrounding, but over time you can get an idea of that from knowing the person. This gift will become most noticeable when someone in your pack is in distress.

Links and channels are incredibly intimate, going beyond even sex, so only link with people who consent verbally or psychically. To link Im with a stranger, to scan their inner thoughts, is spiritual rape and is against Wolf.

STDs: sexually transmitted infections are a part of life and an inevitability of being a wolf. We encourage condom use with those outside of your circuit as well as regular testing. Whenever an infection occurs it is the responsibility of the wolf to notify everyone that they had recent contact with and follow appropriate treatment regiments. Wolf does not grant you immunity from disease.

Drugs: marijuana seems to enhance wolf, and alcohol seems fine as well, however synthetic and hard drugs will interfere with the energy work and wolf connection. Meth in particular is anti-wolf, wolf-bane, and will completely sever a practitioner's connection to wolf energy. Stay away from this substance and all ancillaries. Former meth addicts will also be drawn to your wolf energy as we are the natural version of the high that their drug induced. While we can be healing to former meth users, they have a high likelihood of being a tick and developing unhealthy connections to you.

Animal totems and representations: wolf is the most common animal totem and the way we refer to the God energy representation, however, there are many expressions and variations among people you encounter.



You may sense someone as a fawn or as a badger, you may meet someone who identifies as a cat. All of these are valid expressions as the names themselves, and their totems, are trying to express personalities that can't fully be defined in words. A person may have multiple totems, each one expressing a different sliver of their personality. Yet, all of these totems and names refer to the same person. An apple in English is a pomme in French, but they are both the same fruit, and while one word may refer to the sweetness, another the tart, both are also true of the same apple.

Naming: a wolf name is chosen by the wolf father for the pup. It should come from a place of spirit where the wolf father sees who this person is and can become. It should be genuine at the time of naming and come from an honest, kind place. That being said, names are simply that and will change. You or the new wolf may find better ways of describing each other and that is fine. The first name chosen is not what is sacred, the naming in and of itself is sacred. Whatever you choose, the first name is their identity and the surname is always Wolf. So someone who represents as a badger could be called "Badger Wolf" while a woodsman may be called "Timber Wolf."

Energy filling: most wolf candidates, or pups, can only receive a small portion of wolf energy at a time. You will sense them filling up like a well or a battery. In time you will notice them taking on more and more and maybe even craving it. For some, they will reach a fill point and spark, becoming a full wolf themselves, or they may never spark and only change slowly the more they are exposed. What happens with the energy is not up to you, the giving wolf. You simply radiate and whatever the other person can handle is what they will absorb. Never "force" wolf energy into anyone as this is spiritual rape. The same can be said of delving into the psychic space of someone without their permission.

Ego and wolf: ego is counter to wolf. While we do seek self realization and to be our authentic selves, we do this to be present in the world and help others, not to satisfy an internal need for validation. That need for validation, ego, causes innumerable problems. For this reason it must always be asked whether you are doing it for yourself or for Wolf. The best times are when the answer is *both*. Ego is dangerous for wolves because we are often sought after for sexual gratification. It's very easy to begin to think that

your abilities make you better than others. That can lead to bruised self esteem, addictions, and other dangerous behavior. To believe in Wolf is to believe in something larger than yourself, and the ego doesn't always appreciate that.



Ticks: people who steal energy or otherwise try to interfere in your life. They are not usually conscious of it but you will feel drained around them, negative, or otherwise off. Removing them from your life will be healing but there may be lingering effects.

Feeding: general sex for gratification. Wolf energy is shared with the other and the wolf is also recharged as well. Neither party is devouring the other, rather, energy is being brought in and projected out for all to take in, *to feed*. A wolf will usually "hold back" energy based upon what the other person can handle.

Ministry: sex with a specific healing purpose. Wolf energy is adjusted to meet the needs of the receiver. This can be done with intention but usually happens naturally. You will find yourself adjusting to meet the needs of the other. A lot of wolf energy is held back as usually these people are in very vulnerable, fragile states.

Communion: sex between two wolves, fully charged, nothing held back. Both will take on their primal form and the sex becomes transcendent and often occurs mostly in the energetic (spiritual) plane.

Pup: term of endearment for someone starting the path after you. We refer to potential wolves as pups as well and an older wolf may elect to call you that indefinitely.

Wolf Father: the person who first exposed you to wolf and gave you your name. The mentor to the pup.

Pack: your created family of brethren, wolves, pups, or otherwise.

Pack Meet: a gathering of wolves and potentials to get together and feed.

Potential: someone who may eventually follow the path of Wolf.

Sparking: the act of engaging wolf energy and radiating it into the world and towards others. Observers will often say that you become someone or something else.

Tuning in: the act of sensing the thoughts and feelings of others, particularly other wolves, and connecting into their energy. It works best when one is "broadcasting" and the

other attunes to it. We can feel each other's experiences.

Ping: reaching out to feel another's energy as a check in.

Seeding: casting out wolf energy which is then received and accepted by the partner. The beginning of the process of becoming a wolf.

Blossom/Bloom: a wolf that has stepped into their power and fully actualizes.

Brother Wolf: the name for a wolf that has blossomed. They are no longer the son of their father wolf, they are their brother.

Satyr: the sage, a wise and advanced wolf.

Testing: life situations where a wolf is advanced for growth by their own decisions. This usually involves a difficult situation where the wolf has to decide between what they think they want and what they actually need. Usually an interpersonal price has to be paid. These events push a person towards wolf quickly.

Circuit: your group of sexual partners.

Wolf-bane: Things that are repulsive to wolf and wolf energy. For substances crystal meth is particularly sickening while forced dominant, entitled, behaviors tend to upset wolf as well.
